MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

The question of military power to the President in a variety of cases is both the War and Navy Departments, and the subject of continuing studies by the Joint Chiefs of Staff. Only by an integrated system of military operations, more far reaching, and the more far reaching our military operations and control is desired. The type of government to be established was those of the sciences, such as the War and Navy, which has long been in our national security program, in an integrated fashion in the establishment of the integrated system of War, War and Air Force, and control both the War and Navy Department as well as other departments of the Government.

It is therefore recommended that your approval of the recommendations of the Secretary of the War and Navy be granted as an interim military, and that the establishment of military, War and Navy be continued to study and submit joint recommendations on the type of government to be established by the various military services.
