MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

Subject: Problems Arising From the Administration of
the Pacific Islands

Reference is made to your memorandum of January 9, 1946, in which you express the wish that I call a meeting of the Secretaries of the four Departments, as soon as the Secretary of War returns, to start consideration of the problems arising from the administration of the Pacific Islands. x25

On October 25, 1945, a meeting of representatives of the Secretaries of State, War, the Navy, and the Interior was held, at which an ad hoc sub-committee was appointed to consider these problems. I am taking steps to expedite the work of this sub-committee and as soon as it submits recommendations, and the Secretary of War returns, shall, in accordance with your wishes, call a meeting of the four Secretaries' committee.
