Dear Sherman:

This letter is to tell you that Secretary Dulles has approved the nomination of Mason Sears of Dedham, Massachusetts to be the representative of the United States of America in the Trusteeship Council of the United Nations.

I also talked to the President about Sears being given this appointment last time that I was in Washington on April 3, and he said that he would be glad to approve it if Foster Dulles and I both approved.

I have requested Herb Brownell to expedite the FBI investigation, the report of which, I understand, will go to you.

When FBI clearance has been received, I recommend that the President send the nomination up to the Senate.
