Dear Governor Adams:

Aloha nui. I hope you are going to get away and get a little relaxation this summer. I can't imagine any job that is more time consuming and demanding than yours. You will have to get a set up certainly.

You were kind to write me about the problems of Ambassadorial rank. I certainly think there were too many of those in Europe. But I never have heard anyone speak of overloading of influence and prestige in the Pacific. I really think it would be fair and seemly to balance things of protocol as in contrast with Europe. I wonder if you would like to get Admiral Radford's view on this. He was a High Commissioner with Ambassador's rank before me.

Here's hoping it will work out.
