Financial Notes

The salaries of the Lay Teachers are in excess of \$450 per month.

Considering that 8 Sisters and a Native Seminarian are also being supported by the Mission in the interests of Education, it is evident from the financial records that the cost of running the two schools consumes more than 50% of monthly Mission expenditures.

Food costs for the two dormitories run in excess of \$3,000 per year. The government surplus commodities of milk, rice, butter, cheese and flour enable us to realize a substantial saving in food costs.

Final Educational Notes

The Catholic Mission is planning to open an Elementary School in the village of Ngaraard (Babeldaob Island) in August 1960. At present the Father in charge of the Mission Station in Babeldaob is on sick leave in New York. The Father mentioned is the Rev. Edwin G. McManus, S.J.

The Vicariate of the Caroline-Marshall Islands operates the only High School in the Trust Territory. It is located at Truk in the Caroline Islands and has an enrollment of 75 students. The Palau District has a representation of 32 students, of whom 31 are Palauans and 1 is an American.

The Vicariate also operates a Novitiate and Normal School in Ponape for girls who aspire to be Sisters. It is hoped that in time these girls will return to their home islands and help to staff the local Mission Schools. At present the Palau District has two Native Sisters at the Maris Stella School and sixteen Aspirants to the Sisterhood at Ponape.
