WHEREAS, there is no partiality against the Widows, Orphans of the dead Filipino soldiers and the disabled Filipino veterans, who are receiving equal compensations and other veteran's benefits for American soldiers of WWII.

WHEREAS, the honorably discharged veterans are skilled workers, trained under the Veterans Bill of Right to prepare the veterans for civilian life. However, we are deprived of the right to work under the Federal Service due to disqualification to become American citizens.

We have sturdy belief that the Honorable President will gratify us the justification and equality on the Filipino veteran's eligibility to become American citizens in consideration for practically a lifetime service to the United States Government since the date of enlistment to the U.S. Armed forces.

Optimistic that we will be qualified for American citizenships on this year's naturalization period in Guam, under the same Special Legislation granted to the Filipino AUS veterans naturalized in the Philippines, with sincere gratitude, we wish to thank the Honorable President of America for his sympathetic attention and interest in the Filipino veteran's appeal.

We pray for our Lord's blessing that we may enjoy equal right for employment with the Federal Government.
