October 1, 1963 -- First Micronesian Lawyer Joins High Commissioner's Staff -- Mr. Kaleb Udui of Palau, first Micronesian to obtain a law degree, has been recently appointed to the Staff of the High Commissioner as Assistant Attorney General of the Trust Territory, it was announced by the Office of the High Commissioner.

Mr. Udui spent three years at the University of Hawaii before continuing on at the George Washington University, where he obtained his B.A. degree in 1960. He received his LL.B. this past June from the George Washington Law School and took his bar examinations in Washington D.C. in late August.

While pursuing his law studies in Washington, D.C., Mr. Udui was employed for three years during the summer months in the Office of Territories, Department of Interior.

Mrs. Udui, who was formerly employed as Research Analyst in the Department of Labor, also joined the Program Staff in the Information Office.

High Commissioner M. W. Goding and Attorney General Robert K. Shoecraft in welcoming Mr. Udui to the Headquarters staff congratulated him for his achievement and noted that his appointment as Assistant Attorney General marked a milestone in the legal history of the Trust Territory.
