SAIPAN, M.I....Four members of the House Interior Committee and a member of the House Appropriations Committee are scheduled to arrive in Guam next Monday on the first leg of a planned 11 day inspection trip through the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands.

High Commissioner M. Wilfred Goding announced that Representatives Thomas P. Gill of Honolulu, Edward P. Roybal of California, C.B. Morton of Maryland, Ralph Rivers of Alaska, and W.K. Denton of Indiana will be members of the official party.

Other members include: Robert M. Mangan, Deputy Assistant Secretary, Department of the Interior; James E. Gamble, Professional Staff Member; Senate Interior and Insular Affairs Committee; Dr. John Taylor, member of the House Committee Staff; and Dr. Baron Goto, Vice-Chancellor, East-West Center, University of Hawaii.

The official itinerary presently calls for the group to leave Guam for Saipan on January 13. After three days in the "Capital of Micronesia" the party will again board a plane for a visit to the Yap and Palau District Centers.

They are scheduled to return to Guam January 18 for a three-day visit before again boarding a plane that will carry them to the remaining three District Centers of Truk, Ponape, and Majuro.
