DEAR MR PRESIDENT WE ARE HEREBY RESPECTFULLY AND HUMBLY REQUEST
TO YOUR GOOD OFFICE TO SEND IMMEDIATELY AN INQUIRING BOARD OF
COMMITTEES OF THE HOUSE OF INSULAR AFFAIRS TO INVESTIGATE
CORRUPTION THAT HAS AND IS GOING ON IN AMERICAN SAMOA SINCE
GOVERNOR LEE ASPINAL SECRETARY OF THE GOVERNOR GERGELEY ATTORNEY
GENERAL AND JUDGE MOREAU ARE IN SOLE CONTROL OF THE ISLAND AMONGST

OTHERS IN OUR CASE THE DESECRATION OF OUR GRANDMOTHERS GRAVE ON PRIVATE PROPERTY AND THE CONTINUAL TRESPASS ON PRIVATE PROPERTY BY THE GOVERNMENT ARE THE MAIN ISSUES WE REQUEST THAT OBSERVERS SHOULD BE SENT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE BEFORE OUR CASE COMES UP IN THE HIGH COURT OF AMERICAN SAMOA ON AUGUST 18 OR THAT THE CASE BE POSTPONED UNTIL SUCH INDEPENDENT OBSERVERS CAN ARRIVE HERE THE DIRECT VIOLATION OF THE HUMAN RIGHTS OF THE SAMOAN PEOPLE UNDER THE UNITED NATION CHARTER OF NOVEMBER 18 1948 IS INVOLVED FURTHERMORE THIS IS CALLING FOR A PETITION OF THE PRESENT ADMINISTRATION OF AMERICAN SAMOA FOR REDRESS UNDER THE
