MARSHALLS MEDICAL CONSULTANT REPORTS FOR DUTY

Deisher of Seward, Alaska, arrived in Kwajalein yesterday en route to the Marshalls District Center of Majuro, where he will assume his appointment as Senior Medical Consultant at the Armer Ishoda Memorial Hospital, according to an announcement from the High Commissioner's Office.

The 48-year-old doctor is accompanied by his wife, Elizabeth, and three children--two sons and a daughter.

A graduate of the University of Rochester, School of Medicine and Dentistry, New York, Dr. Deisher has been in private medical practice in Seward, Alaska, for the past several years.

With the assignment of Dr. Deisher to the Marshalls, five of the six district center hospitals now have U.S. Senior Medical Consultants on the staff. The Headquarters medical authorities said active recruitment is now under way for one US MD to fill the consultant position at Yap District Hospital vacated by a former incumbent who returned to the United States after serving one year.
