### HIGH COMMISSIONER LEAVES FOR COUNCIL HEARINGS

SAIPAN, M.I. (May 21)...High Commissioner M. W. Goding is scheduled to leave Saipan Saturday, May 22, to attend the annual United Nations Trusteeship Council hearings scheduled to open in New York May 26.

It is planned that Mr. Goding will spend a few days in Washington, D.C. conferring with State and Interior Department officials before going on to New York and the United Nations.

Mr. John E. deYoung, Assistant Commissioner for Public Affairs, left Saipan on Thursday to also attend the Trusteeship Council hearings. He is to meet with the Special Micronesian Advisor to the United States Delegation, Mr. *Barley Oltu*, in Honolulu before going on to Washington, D.C. to meet the High Commissioner.

Current plans call for the group to return to their respective posts in the Trust Territory in mid-June.
