AGRICULTURE TRADE SCHOOL TO OPEN IN TRUST TERRITORY

SAIPAN, M.I. (July 28)...The Ponape Agriculture Trade School, recently granted a charter by High Commissioner M. W. Goding, will open in the fall of 1965 in Metalanim, Ponape, under the sponsorship of the Roman Catholic Mission of the Caroline and Marshall Islands.

Staff of the school is as follows: Rev. Edward A. Soucie, S.J., principal; Rev. Hugh Costigan, S.J.; Rev. Joseph A. Cavanaugh, S.J.; Nick Soriano; and Russ Varner.

The school will be a four year boarding school for high school boys, exclusively devoted to instruction in agriculture and the trades. It will combine classroom and outside instruction with training in responsibility and leadership. Tuition is \$15 a month.

The first 9th grade class of 25 to 30 boys will begin in September 1965. A grade will be added each year until the school becomes a four year high school.
