HEINE OFFICIALLY SWORN IN AS NEW DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR  
MARSHALLS, RESIGNS AS SPEAKER

SAIPAN, M. I. (OCT 26)...Dwight Heine of the Marshalls, first Micronesian to be appointed by the High Commissioner to the highest executive post in the district organization, was officially sworn in October 15 as the new administrator of the Marshall Islands District during an impressive public ceremony before the Marshall Islands Congress at Majuro.

Heine took over the administratorship from District Administrator Peter T. Coleman, who has been transferred to Saipan to assume a similar post in the Marianas District. Coleman arrived in Saipan October 21. Alan MacQuarrie, who has been acting District Administrator for the Marianas District since last August, left Saipan October 23 for Truk as the administrator for that district.

With his official assumption of duties as the District Administrator, Marshalls, on October 15, Heine simultaneously resigned as Speaker of the General Assembly, First Congress of Micronesia. Vice-Speaker Petrus Mailo of Truk has been designated Acting Speaker of the Assembly until the new Speaker is elected at the next session.
