SOCIAL SECURITY PLAN ENVISAGED FOR TRUST TERRITORY

SAIPAN, M. I. (NOV 26)...Robert J. Myers, Chief Actuary of the U. S. Social Security Administration, has been traveling throughout the Trust Territory for the past two weeks preparatory to making recommendations on possibilities for eventual establishment of a "social security" system for Trust Territory citizens. He will return to Washington, D. C., this week where he will draft his report.

Prior to coming to the Trust Territory this year, Mr. Myers and his wife, Ruth, attended the International Social Security Association Meeting which was held in Geneva, Switzerland, and the United Nations World Population Conference held in Belgrade, Yugoslavia. They also traveled to Jordan, Saudi Arabia and Iran where Mr. Myers provided technical assistance to these governments.

Mr. Myers has worked in various actuarial positions with the U. S. Social Security Administration since 1934. He has been Chief Actuary since 1947. He is a member of the Committee of Social
