ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE WELCOMES NEW STAFF MEMBER

SAIPAN, M. I. (NOV 29). . . Mrs. Charlotte E. Libman of Chicago, Illinois, has joined the legal staff of the Trust Territory as administrative assistant to the Attorney General.

Mrs. Libman took her pre-legal training at the University of Oklahoma and Brooklyn College, and received her LL.B. degree from Brooklyn Law School. She was admitted to the Illinois Bar in 1941 and began her practice of law at that time. In 1955 she founded a wholesale costume jewelry business in Chicago and spent the next 10 years successfully combining a legal and business career. In 1965, the widely-traveled Mrs. Libman applied for and was employed at her present job in the Attorney General's Office.

Mrs. Libman has been extremely busy since arriving in the Trust Territory in October 1965. From November 12-19, she represented the Attorney General at the Trust Territory Judicial Conference which was held in Palau. "At that time," she said, "I became aware of the tremendous job the Judiciary is doing in spite of the vast problems facing it."
