### ECONOMIC CONSULTANT VISITS TRUST TERRITORY

SAIPAN, M. I. (DEC 5). . .Edward D. Hollander, vice president, Robert R. Nathan Associates, Inc., is in the Trust Territory for one week to consult with Trust Territory officials and members of the Economic Development Team on the status of the work entailed in the Territory's contract with Nathan Associates regarding the development and implementation of a long-range economic development program.

Mr. Hollander has served as advisor on economic development to several foreign governments. He has directed technical assistance provided to local redevelopment areas in the United States, and economic research projects for several metropolitan cities. He has prepared expert testimony for use in proceedings before many regulatory agencies of the United States Government. His prior activities include service as economist for the U.S. Department of Labor; secretary of the Planning Committee, War Manpower Commission; chief of the Bureau of Labor Statistics' Division of Prices and Cost of Living; labor economist on the

staff of the Council of Economic Advisers; on the Labor Advisory Commission to the military government in Japan; as national director of Americans for Democratic Action; and manpower consultant to the Ford Foundation. He was assistant chief of the Planning Division of the War Manpower Commission in 1942-43, and

Planning Division of the War Relocation Commission in 1943-44, and saw sea service in the U.S. Navy in 1944-45.
