#### PALAU HAS NEW COOPERATIVE OFFICER

SAIPAN, N. I. (DEC 17)...Francis S. White, of Seattle, Washington, and his wife, Betty, arrived in Palau on November 29, where he has assumed the duties of District Cooperative Officer. Mr. White who has been engaged in credit union work for more than 25 years, succeeds Karl Schug who return to the United States in August to resume higher education studies.

Mr. White comes to the Trust Territory from a position as Treasurer-Manager of the Washington Central Credit Union, an organization serving members throughout the entire state. Previously, he was Managing Director of the Washington Credit Union League, an organization consisting of more than 200 credit unions in the state, and he was also prominent in nation-wide credit union circles. Mr. White served as Treasurer of the Safety Federal Credit Union, Los Angeles, California, serving employees of the B.F. Goodrich Tire & Rubber Company, and he was also Assistant Treasurer of the Long Beach Naval Shipyard Federal Credit Union. During his long career, he organized more than 150 credit unions. This background will be of special usefulness in Palau district.

Mr. White was born in Chicago, Illinois and received his B.A. degree from Asbury College in Kentucky. His son, Richard, attends Princeton University, and will graduate next year.
