FIELD TRAINING COURSE IN FAMILY LIVING TO BE HELD

SATPAN, M. I. (DECEMBER 22)... The Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, in cooperation with the East-West Center, University of Hawaii, will conduct a two-week field training course in Family Living in Majuro, Marshall Islands, beginning January 13.

The primary emphasis of the course will be in three fields:

- (1) raising flowers, food, pigs and poultry for home use;
- (2) new ways to prepare commonly raised and "newer" foods;
- (3) how to improve home sanitation (control of rats and house-hold insects), keep a safe water supply and construction of a sanitary water-seal toilet.

The coordinator of the course is James Ia Forest, Director of
Adult Education in the Marshalls. Resource people who will be present
from outside the Territory are Catalina Shea, food technologist, from
the Philippines and Miss Beatrice Billings, Program Director, Women's
Career and Youth Development Program, Institute for Technical Interchange, East-West Center, University of Hawaii. The course will draw
on local resource people in agriculture, sanitation, public health,
community development and education.
