FIRST MICRONESIAN WOMAN GRADUATES FROM FIJI SCHOOL OF MEDICINE

SAIPAN, MARIANA ISLANDS (December 23)...Ulai Trudy Otobed of Palau has become the first Micronesian woman medical practitioner and at the same time has won recognition for her outstanding performance at the Fiji School of Medicine in Suva.

At the graduation of the School held December 10, Miss Otobed won the British Medical Association (Fiji Branch) Gold Metal in Surgery, the Glazo-Allenburys Prize for the highest aggregate marks, and the Principal's Presentation to the top girl student.

Other Trust Territory students who received the Diploma from the Fiji School of Medicine were Aminis L. David, Ponape, and Arthur P. Sigras, Ponape. Receiving certificates in Laboratory Technology were Edwin Talley Bonaventure, Yap, Herman deLeon Guerrero, Marianas, and Lunuknuk Jormelu Calvin, Marshalls, while Mamoru Kabua Kabua, Marshalls, received his Certificate of Radiography.
