PONAPE HIGH CHIEF SUCCUMBS

SAIPAN, MARIANA ISLANDS, TRUST TERRITORY OF THE PACIFIC ISLANDS, (FEBRUARY 23)...Moses Hadley, Nammwarki of Metalanim and ranking traditional chief of the entire Ponape District, died at his home at Tempen Island, Metalanim, early Saturday morning, February 19, after an illness of several years, according to a dispatch received by Trust Territory Headquarters.

Nanmwarki Moses received the highest hereditary title and position in 1932. Ponape residents of younger generations remember no other Nanmwarki than Moses Hadley.

More than a thousand friends from all areas of Ponape converged on Tempen Island Saturday and Sunday to pay honor to the deceased Nanmwarki and to acknowledge and honor his successor, his younger brother, Samuel Hadley. Both Catholic and Protestant eulogies and services were said before interment Sunday morning.

Nammwarki Moses was born April 10, 1894, in Metalanim. After succeeding to his high rank and title, he was also appointed "soncho" or headman of Metalanim during the years of Japanese mandate administration and had been elected chief magistrate for 14 years under the present Trust Territory administration until he withdrew his candidacy in favor of younger successors.

Nanmwarki Moses is survived by his wife and ten children, a number of whom hold responsible positions in local and Trust Territory governments as well as holding traditional titled ranks.
