NEW PUBLICATIONS OFFICER ARRIVES

SAIPAN, MARIANA ISLANDS, TRUST TERRITORY OF THE PACIFIC ISLANDS, (March 3)...The appointment of Mr. William Edward Rimmel of Library, Pennsylvania, as Superintendent of the Trust Territory Publications Office was announced today by High Commissioner M. W. Goding.

Mr. Rimmel, a native Pennsylvanian, comes to his new post in the Territory with 12 years of intensive publications and printing experience.

As an undergraduate at the University of Pennsylvania, Mr. Rimmel combined a course program in electrical engineering with publications work. After leaving the University in 1955, he became an engineering writer for the Westinghouse Bettis Atomic Power Laboratory. In 1961 he founded in partnership his own firm, R. & D. Publications Consultants, which specialized in technical publications. In 1962, the firm was sold to R. & D. Publications, Inc., and he served as general manager for this firm until 1963 when he joined the Westinghouse Astronuclear Laboratory as engineer. In this latter post he was responsible for all publications production work of this firm. Thus, he brings to the Territory and his new position experience not only in actual production techniques, but in writing and editing as well.

As Printing Superintendent of the Headquarters Publications Office, Mr. Rimmel will be in charge of all publications production under the general supervision of the Assistant Commissioner for Public Affairs. The new Publications Office, formerly known as the Literature Production Center, was organized by Mr. Bruce Roberts who served as Literature Production Specialist and Publications Officer from 1963 to 1965.

Mr. Rimmel is accompanied by his wife, Elizabeth Jean, and their two children, William, 3, and Laura, 1.
