SAIPAN IS MECCA FOR ANDERSEN AFB "TOURISTS IN UNIFORM"

July 1 . . . The first 30 airman to participate in Andersen AFB's
"Saipan Career, Incentive Flights" arrived June 29 aboard a C-97 aircraft.

The two-day sight-seeing trips were initiated by the Air Force as a stimulus to retain first-term airmen and junior officers.
