UTWE CREDIT UNION CHARTERED

Saipan, Mariana Islands, Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, July 13 . . . A Trust Territory credit union charter for the residents of Utwe, Village of Kusaie, in Ponape District, was signed by High Commissioner William R. Norwood today. The articles of incorporation and by laws were submitted by District Cooperative Officer Mort Colodny, under whose guidance the credit union was organized.

Several additional cooperative and credit union charters are being processed and will be submitted on the return of Headquarters Cooperative Officer Samuel Mitchell, in about two weeks, according to Acting Headquarters Cooperative Officer Charles M. Sicard. Sicard said the growing number of charter requests is an indication of the rapid development of cooperatives in the Trust Territory.
