July 28 . . . Eusebio Rechucher of Palau District was sworn in as
Deputy Assistant Commissioner for Resources and Development at the

quarters.

Mr. Rechucher will share with Paul L. Winsor, Assistant Commis-
sioner for Resources and Development, the responsibility for adminis-

chairman or participating member of various boards, committees and
other groups including the Copra Stabilization Board. He will also
serve as Loan Officer and as such is responsible for the program of
planning and preparing loan applications for review by the Economic
Development Loan Fund Board.

Mr. Rechucher was born and received his early education in Koror,
Palau. He attended Black Hills State College in South Dakota where he
