TRUST TERRITORY NURSE TO ATTEND
WHO SEMINAR IN MANILA

Saipan, Mariana Islands, Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, Oct. 20 . . . Mrs. Irene Rowland, Supervisory Clinical Nurse in charge of the Trust Territory School of Nursing will attend the World Health Organization (WHO) first regional seminar on education and training of auxiliary health personnel.

The seminar will convene at the WHO regional headquarters in Manila, Philippines, October 24 to 31.

Mrs. Rowland said the objectives of the seminar are to review the various training programs for auxiliary health personnel in the region; to consider the various factors involved in the training of auxiliary health personnel; and to make recommendations on future training, utilization, supervision and guidance of auxiliary health personnel in the light of local conditions.

Auxiliary health personnel include medical assistants, nurses, midwives, sanitation personnel and nurse aides.

In 1964 Mrs. Rowland traveled to Bangkok, Thailand, to represent the Trust Territory at the WHO seminar on nutrition.

Mrs. Rowland departed Saipan October 19 and is scheduled to return on November 9.
