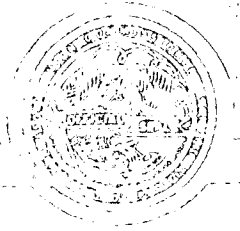

COORDINATING COMMITTEE FOR DISTAD CONFERENCE CREATED

Saipan, Mariana Islands, Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands,
Oct. 26 . . . In order that plans and agenda for the 1966 District
Administrators' Conference, tentatively scheduled for the week commencing
December 5, may move ahead as rapidly as possible, a six-man Conference
Coordinating Committee has been established with Management Improvement
Officer L. K. Anderson serving as Chairman.

Other members of the Coordinating Committee are Assistant
Commissioners John E. deYoung, James E. Hawkins, Joseph Screen, Paul L.
Winsor, and Marianas District Administrator Peter T. Coleman.

Among the major items to be taken up during the five-day Conference
will be the utilization of the Planning, Programming, and Budgeting
concept; a new approach to the relationship between the High Commissioner,
members of Headquarters staff, and the District Administrators, the
utilization of the Peace Corps to supplement the Trust Territory programs,
and other matters of high importance.
