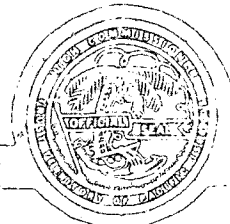

The following people have been elected by their district legislatures and certified to the High Commissioner to represent all six districts for the first time at the Semi-annual meeting of the Copra Stabilization Board to be held on January 20, 1967, at Trust Territory Headquarters, Saipan:

Among the various items to be discussed in the meeting will be a report to be given by Russ Curtis, Manager of the United Micronesia Development Association, on the UMDA copra operation. On November 10, 1966, a two-year contract was signed between the United Micronesia Development Association and the Copra Stabilization Board for purchase and marketing of copra throughout the Trust Territory.
