NEW ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER ARRIVES IN SAIPAN

Saipan, Mariana Islands, Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, Jan. 25 . . . N. Neiman Craley, Jr., recently appointed Assistant Commissioner for Public Affairs, arrived in Saipan this morning to assume his new duties. Mr. Craley was welcomed by High Commissioner W.R. Norwood, Deputy High Commissioner Martin P. Mangan, Acting Assistant Commissioner for Public Affairs Raymond Ulochong and other members of his staff.

Ponape

The former member of the U.S. House of Representatives from Pennsylvania was appointed Assistant Commissioner for Public Affairs on January 5 replacing John E. deYoung who transferred to the Department of the Interior as Deputy Assistant Director of the Office of Territories.

Yap

During Mr. Craley's term in the 89th Congress, he was a member of the Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs. During that time, he attended, as an observer, a session of the Trusteeship Council in June of 1965, and in July was an official representative of the Committee and the U.S. Congress at the first session of the Congress of Micronesia. Later, in the fall of 1965, he was a member of a Congressional group which made an inspection tour of the Trust Territory.
