OEP. REPRESENTATIVE TO EVALUATE TYPHOON DAMAGE IN PALAU

Saipan, Mariana Islands, Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, Mar. 9 . . . Mr. Ralph Burns, Disaster Assistance Coordinator (Region 7), President's Office of Emergency Planning, arrived in Palau today to conduct an on-the-spot survey of damages inflicted by Typhoon Sally, which unexpectedly swept over Koror and Babelthuap on March 2. He arrived in Saipan yesterday morning to confer with Deputy High Commissioner Martin P. Mangan who headed a six-man typhoon survey team to Palau last week.

Mr. Burns will gather first-hand information on the extent of typhoon damage and make recommendations whether Palau could be eligible for Federal disaster assistance. He is expected to return to Guam on Sunday, March 12.

Mr. Burns' office is located in Santa Rosa, California.
