Saipan, Mariana Islands, Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands,
March 9 . . . An Andersen AFE, Guam, C-97 Eoeing Stratocruiser thundered
to a stop at Palau's Airai Airfield, Thursday afternoon. The cargo,
somewhat unusual for a military aircraft, was happily received by the
people of Palau. Seven tons of local foods from Yap and 100 cartons of
clothing collected on Guam and Wake Islands formed a large part of this
cargo. This is the second emergency relief flight that Andersen AFB
has made to Palau since March 2 when Typhoon Sally surprised the islands,
leaving thousands homeless and without food and clothing.

Major Gordon T. Caldwell who coordinated the flight with Trust
Territory Liaison Officer Gordon Findley considered the mission one of
the most satisfying that he has ever flown particularly when he learned
that eleven little girls reported to school today in the nightclothes
they were wearing when their homes were swept away. Tomorrow the young
ladies can wear garments generously donated by well-wishing Pacific
neighbors.
