

During the seminar, major emphasis will be placed upon the study of the mental and behavior disorders associated with economic and social change occurring in the Pacific territories. A report with recommendations will be prepared by the participants and consultants of the seminar.

The seminar resulted from the suggestions of three South Pacific psychiatrists during an informal consultative meeting in May, 1968. A three-week course was planned for health educators, teachers, social welfare workers, etc. Approved by the Commission at its 29th session in October, 1966, the course was developed into a two-week seminar for a high level of professional workers in the field.
