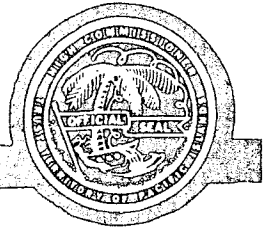

### RESTRICTION ON ENTRY OF DOGS AND CATS CONTINUES

Saipan, Mariana Islands, Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, June 23 . . . . To prevent the introduction of rabies, no dogs or cats originating from Guam have been allowed to enter the Trust Territory since April 4, 1957. This 90-day prohibition has been extended indefinitely, according to Dr. Luke A. Howe, Assistant Director of Public Health.

By order of the Trust Territory/of Public Health, dogs and cats are prohibited from entering the Trust Territory by aircraft or surface vessel. Animals transiting Guam from outside the Trust Territory shall be allowed to enter provided the owner possesses a certificate that the animal has been confined during the time spent on Guam at an airport terminal, dock, or government quarantine station.
