#### INTRODUCTION

This report provides data on Federal outlays for the first half of fiscal year 1968 for more than 850 program, activity, or appropriation items. These data are summarized at the State and National levels by agency, program, and budget function. At the county level data are detailed by program, activity, or appropriation.

The report is published for the Executive Office of the President by the Information Center of the Office of Economic Opportunity, through its Federal Information Exchange System. The data contained herein are the products of a joint effort of all Federal Departments and Agencies in response to the requirements of the Bureau of the Budget under Circular A-84.

#### Precaution on Use of Data

These data provide a useful guide to the general nature and order of magnitude of the Federal impact on the Nation's States, counties, and local communities. However in some cases agency accounting systems do not provide data by geographic location and approximations or statistical derivations have been made. Therefore the reader should exercise care in the interpretation, quotation, or summary of individual figures.

Efforts are being made continuously to improve the accuracy and precision of the data and to eliminate inconsistencies in reporting. However, because of the newness and evolutionary stage of the development of the Federal Information Exchange System and the individual agency feeder systems which produce the data, the following precautions should be observed:

- In some cases reporting is incomplete because of security reasons.
- Trust funds and regular appropriation funds are reported without distinction.
- The figures for insured and guaranteed loan programs include the face value of loans rather than the cost of the program's operation.
- Information on the activities of certain agencies, boards, or commissions will be found in the report of an agency to which funds were transferred or which performed the accounting, rather than the funding agency.
- "Federal Outlays" generally mean obligations of government administered funds, except deposit funds. However, in some instances the data may represent costs.
- Information is provided by program and appropriation, where funds have not been allocated among specific programs.
- As mentioned above, approximations or statistical derivations may have been used.
