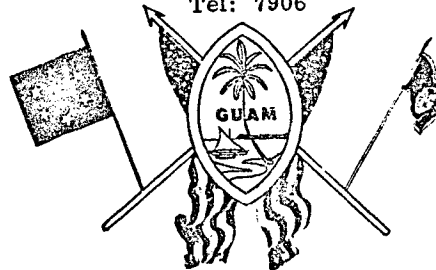



Resolution No. 1

Executive Committee

Relative to thanking the Honorable Richard M. Nixon, President of the United States, for his support and endorsement of the Pacific Conference of Legislators.

1           WHEREAS, the Honorable Richard M. Nixon, President of the  
 2 United States, has expressed his wholehearted endorsement of  
 3 the organization, purposes, directions and activities of this  
 4 conference; and

5           WHEREAS, in addition to his personal endorsement he has  
 6 also caused a representative of his administration to attend  
 7 this conference as a presidential observer and to lend  
 8 presidential support; and

9           WHEREAS, the support of President Nixon at this crucial  
 10 stage in the history of the conference when, for the first  
 11 time, it is being held in one of the districts of the Trust  
 12 Territory, is of great importance since the government of the  
 13 Trust Territory is a Federal activity and thus no greater  
 14 encouragement for full support from this government can be  
 15 accomplished than by such presidential endorsement; and

16           WHEREAS, President Nixon himself played a role during the  
 17 Second World War in the liberation of these islands from their  
 18 oppressors, and he has consistently demonstrated a warm and  
 19 sympathetic interest in the peoples of Micronesia, as recently  
 20 evidenced by his appointment of a native Guamanian as Governor  
 21 of Guam and of an outstanding well-qualified resident of  
 22 Hawaii as High Commissioner of the Trust Territory; and


23           WHEREAS, the theme of the Nixon administration, as  
 24 expressed in the President's moving inaugural address is "To  
 25 go forward together", and although the reference was to the


1 people of the United States themselves, this theme also  
2 summarizes the goal of the members of this conference who hope  
3 to bring progress both in self-government and in social gains  
4 to the people of all the islands together; now therefore be it

5       RESOLVED, that the Pacific Conference of Legislators does  
6 hereby express to the Honorable Richard M. Nixon, President  
7 of the United States, warm thanks and deep gratitude for his  
8 endorsement and support of the conference; and be it further

9       RESOLVED, that the President certify to and the Secretary  
10 attest the adoption hereof and that a copy of the same be  
11 thereafter transmitted to the Honorable Richard M. Nixon,  
12 President of the United States.
