Executive Committee

Relative to thanking the Honorable Richard M. Nixon, President of the United States, for his support and endorsement of the Pacific Conference of Legislators.

WHEREAS, the Honorable Richard M. Nixon, President of the United States, has expressed his wholehearted endorsement of the organization, purposes, directions and activities of this conference; and

WHEREAS, in addition to his personal endorsement he has also caused a representative of his administration to attend this conference as a presidential observer and to lend presidential support; and

whereas, the support of President Nixon at this crucial stage in the history of the conference when, for the first time, it is being held in one of the districts of the Trust Territory, is of great importance since the government of the Trust Territory is a Federal activity and thus no greater encouragement for full support from this government can be accomplished than by such presidential endorsement; and

WHEREAS, President Nixon himself played a role during the Second World War in the liberation of these islands from their oppressors, and he has consistently demonstrated a warm and sympathetic interest in the peoples of Micronesia, as recently evidenced by his appointment of a native Guamanian as Governor of Guam and of an outstanding well-qualified resident of Hawaii as High Commissioner of the Trust Territory; and

WHEREAS, the theme of the Nixon administration, as expressed in the President's moving inaugural address is "To go forward together", and although the reference was to the

people of the United States themselves, this theme also summarizes the goal of the members of this conference who hope to bring progress both in self-government and in social gains to the people of all the islands together; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Pacific Conference of Legislators does hereby express to the Honorable Richard M. Nixon, President of the United States, warm thanks and deep gratitute for his endorsement and support of the conference; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the President certify to and the Secretary attest the adoption hereof and that a copy of the same be thereafter transmitted to the Honorable Richard M. Nixon, President of the United States.
