WHEREAS, reintegration with United States Territory of Guam is the offspring of the basic legal fundamental concept contained in the Charter of the United Nations and the Trusteeship Agreement; and

WHEREAS, reference is made to Article 87 of the Charter of the United Nations which provides as follows:

#### "Article 87

The General Assembly and, under its authority, the Trusteeship Council, in carrying out their function, may:

- a. consider reports submitted by the administering authority;
- accept petitions and examine them in consultation with the administering authority;
- c. provide for periodic visits to the respective trust territories at times agreed upon with the administering authority; and
- d. take these and other actions in conformity with the terms of the trusteeship agreement;" and

WHEREAS, reference is made and should be noted under Subsection (b) of the aforesaid article upon which rests the inhabitants of the Marianas District their rights to petition, same having been exercised through a referendum media held on November 9, 1969, the result of which was overwhelmingly in favor of reintegration with Guam; and

WHEREAS, Article 73 of the Charter of the United Nations provides as follows:

#### "Article 73

Members of the United Nations which have or assume responsibilities for the administration of territories whose peoples have not yet attained a full
