
Dear Mr. President:

A RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING
AND MEMORIALIZING THE UNITED NATIONS TRUSTEESHIP
COUNCIL DELEGATION TO GIVE THE RIGHT OF THE INHA-
BITANTS OF THE MARIANAS DISTRICT TO REINTEGRATE
WITH THE UNITED STATES TERRITORY OF GUAM

1. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TWENTY-SECOND SAIPAN LEGISLATURE, THAT:

2. WHEREAS, reintegration with United States Territory of Guam is the off-
3. spring of the basic legal fundamental concept contained in the Charter of the
4. United Nations and the Trusteeship Agreement; and

5. WHEREAS, reference is made to Article 87 of the Charter of the United
6. Nations which provides as follows:

7. "Article 87

8. The General Assembly and, under its authority, the Trusteeship
9. Council, in carrying out their function, may:

10. a. consider reports submitted by the administering authority;
11. b. accept petitions and examine them in consultation with the
12. administering authority;
13. c. provide for periodic visits to the respective trust
14. territories at times agreed upon with the administering
15. authority; and
16. d. take these and other actions in conformity with the terms
17. of the trusteeship agreement;" and

18. WHEREAS, reference is made and should be noted under Subsection (b) of
19. the aforesaid article upon which rests the inhabitants of the Marianas District
20. their rights to petition, same having been exercised through a referendum media
21. held on November 9, 1969, the result of which was overwhelmingly in favor of
22. reintegration with Guam; and
