SUBJECT: Micronesia

In reviewing your memorandum concerning lack of progress on Micronesia (10308) the President made the following comments:

- The idea of embarking on a new policy line such as a district-by-district plebiscite is probably a good one.
- Another possibility would be to send a good team of Hawaiians to Micronesia to sell the idea of statehood by joining Hawaii.
