SUBJECT: Presidential Appointment with
Secretary Morton

As you know, the President has asked to see Secretary Morton and we have reserved 3:30 p.m. on Tuesday, April 27, for the appointment.

For the first 10 minutes, Secretary Morton should arrange to bring in Dr. Franklin Haydn Williams, Personal Representative for the negotiation of future political status of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands. There will be a photo opportunity of Dr. Williams receiving his commission; however, Dr. Williams should be sworn in prior to this meeting with the President. By copy of this memorandum, I am notifying Dr. Kissinger of this commitment. I am assuming that he will work with your office on the briefing paper and let my office know whether or not he plans to be present for this portion of the President's appointment with Secretary Morton.

The last 20 minutes of the appointment will be devoted to Interior Department matters and you should plan to be present for this discussion.

Please let my office know if Secretary Morton and Dr. Williams can be available at 3:30 p.m. on Tuesday, April 27.
