

April 27, 1971, 3:30 P.M. (10 minutes)

The President is receiving Secretary Morton and Dr. Williams for ten minutes at 3:30 p.m. Tuesday, April 27. This is Dr. Williams first opportunity to meet with the President since receiving his appointment as Personal Representative for Negotiation with the Trust Territory last month.

You are expected to be present for the ten minutes when Dr. Williams is with the President. Secretary Morton will remain for another twenty minutes without Dr. Williams on Interior business.

At Tab A is a memorandum for your signature containing suggested talking points for the President's meeting with Dr. Williams and Secretary Morton.
