Mr. Klein has asked me to thank you for your letter of February 4.

I have enclosed a copy of the report you wanted. As far as the possibility of President Nixon meeting with Micronesian leaders is concerned, his stop on Guam is simply an overnight one. Since he will be arriving in the evening and leaving early the next morning, there will not be time for such a meeting. However, a group including the Governor of Guam and the Speaker of the Legislature will be greeting the President at the airport.
