Dear Mr. Midkiff:

Your letter of December 26, 1972, to the President reporting on your recent trip to the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands was very much appreciated. The area is one in which the President has had a personal interest for a number of years, and I can assure you that your recommendations will be given careful consideration.

As you may know, a special study of our relations with Micronesia is currently being made under the direction of Ambassador Author Williams, the President's Personal Representative for Micronesian Status Negotiations. The observations and constructive suggestions contained in your letter are, therefore, particularly timely. You may be sure they will be taken fully into account during the course of that study, which will contain a series of important recommendations for the President.

The specific problems you cite are, of course, being given priority attention by High Commissioner Johnston and other responsible officials in Saipan.

As you may be aware, Ambassador Williams is now on an extended trip in Asia and will undoubtedly have further comments for you on his return.
