

Memorandum

To: Chairman, Under Secretaries Committee From: Chairman, Interagency Study Group on Guam Subject: Guam Study

By memorandum dated September 12, 1973, you directed that an interagency study be conducted under the chairmanship of the Department of Interior to determine U.S. national objectives, policies and programs in Guam in order to identify prospective courses of action by which U.S. interests may most effectively be fostered. At present, the study is targeted for completion no later than December 17, 1973.

The principals of the Interagency Study Group on Guam (ISG/G) met on October 1 to reach agreement on format and terms of reference. In subsequent meetings the ISG/G has determined that the study should be broken into two phases. Phase one would include the interagency agreed position on U.S. interests and objectives in Guam. These sections of the study would be completed by the original December 17, 1973, deadline and would be circulated among the principals of the ISG/G for approval. Phase two would consider Guamanian concerns and would include consultation with Guamanian leaders. Phase two would be completed February 1, 1974. The completed study, including both phases and the options and recommendations derived therefrom, would be forwarded to the Under Secretaries Committee by COB February 7, 1974.

Accordingly, the ISG/G requests approval be given to the approach and revised deadline described above.
