Cleron

- a. The basic Commonwealth relationship between the United States and the Northern Mariana Islands established in Title I of the Agreement.
- b. The conditions under which citizens of the Marianas may become United States citizens or nationals under Title II.
- c. The right of the people of the Marianas to Aadopt and amend their own Constitution under Title IV.
- d. The application to the Northern Mariana Islands of specified provisions of the U.S. Constitution under Title V.
- e. The procedures to be followed in the exercise of federal powers of eminent domain under Title VIII.
