Meeting lasted for two hours.

- PB
- Busy to 18th elsewhere.
  - Thread: eventual unity with Guam.
  - Mutual Consent.
  - Likes U.S. list.
  - No real comments on MPSC list - but fewer exceptions <sup>and</sup> no better.
  - Taxes
    - Likes language on application.
    - Right to amend (Sheehan checking re: Puerto Rico-Guam problem).
    - Shipping good.
  - Minimum wages - add hours.
  - Representation
    - Resident Commissioner title out.
    - (Superior to non-voting delegate).
    - No pay - no incentive for union with Guam.
    - Liaison Office OK - should work with Won Pat.
  - Land - Strong anti-purchase.
    - Military hard liner influence fading.
    - Take Jones out (returned contribution).
  - Timetable - early Congressional tie-in.
    - Consult with Marianas before plebescite regarding Congressional problems.
    - Money-relaxed, generally no problems.
