SUBJECT: Proposed White House Announcement of New Deputy to Ambassador F. Haydn Williams, the President's Personal Representative for Micronesian Status Negotiations

At Tab A is a draft White House press release which would announce the designation of Mr. Charles Schmitz, a Foreign Service Reserve Officer of Class 2, as the U. S. Deputy Representative for Micronesian Status Negotiations. Although the designation would not be made by the White House, it would be announced by the White House in order to give additional status to Schmitz as Ambassador Williams' deputy for the useful effect this would have on his role in these negotiations. This procedure would follow the same as that used for Mr. Schmitz's predecessor when his designation was announced in October 1972 (a copy of that announcement is at Tab B).

The President today announced the designation of Charles A. Schmitz, a Foreign Service Reserve Officer of Class 2, as the U.S. Deputy Representative for Micronesian Status Negotiations, effective May , 1975. Mr. Schmitz will serve as the deputy of Ambassador Haydn Williams, the President's Personal Representative for Micronesian Status Negotiations, and also as Chairman of an Inter-Agency Working Group on Micronesia's future political status under the aegis of the Under Secretaries Committee.

Mr. Schmitz until recently was Assistant Legal Adviser for African Affairs, Department of State. His last post was Tokyo, where he served as Legal Adviser and political-military counselor. Mr. Schmitz was graduated from Yale College in 1960 and has an LL. B. from Yale Law School.

The President today announced the designation of James M. Wilson, Jr., a Foreign Service Officer of Class 1, as the U. S. Deputy Representative for Micronesian Status Negotiations, effective November 1, 1972. Mr. Wilson will serve as the principal deputy of Ambassador Franklin Haydn Williams, the President's Personal Representative for Micronesian Status Negotiations, and also as chairman of an Inter-Agency Group working on Micronesia's future political status under the aegis of the Under Secretaries Committee.

Mr. Wilson until recently was a Deputy Assistant Secretary of State for East Asian and Pacific Affairs; he has served in a wide variety of posts in Asia. His last post was Manila, where he served as Deputy Chief of Mission with the personal rank of minister. Mr. Wilson was graduated from Swarthmore College in 1939 and has an M. A. from the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy and an LL. B. from Harvard University.
