Professor Holliday's Recommendation of Fred K. Fox

Jack Marsh sent you a copy of a letter from a Professor Sam C. Holliday complaining about Ambassador Haydn Williams' performance in the Micronesian negotiations and proposing a possible successor (Tab B). Although Ambassador Williams has talked informally about resigning sometime after Congressional approval of the resolution on the Marianas, we believe it is premature to begin consideration of possible successors.

At Tab A is a draft memorandum from you to Mr. Marsh thanking him for sending you the letter but also indicating that consideration of successors is premature.
