SUBJECT: Micronesian Compact of Free Association

Bud, I think a clear leadership roll needs to be affirmed or established in order to resolve, to our satisfaction, the differences of opinion on the Compact, both within the Executive Branch and on the Hill. Due to the national security implications of this compact, perhaps you would want to look into this.

The Compact is on a fast track in the primary jurisdictional committee and the work product adopted at the subcommittee level is unacceptable to Ambassador Zeder.
