The Interagency Group on Micronesia will convene on Wednesday, August 28 at 4:30 p.m. in the Deputy Secretary's Conference Room (room 7219) in the Department of State. Under Secretary for Political Affairs Michael Armacost will chair. Each principal may be accompanied by one assistant.

Ambassador Zeder will report on his Honolulu consultations with the Micronesians. A cleared memorandum to the NSC stating the IG's position on Compact tax and trade issues will be circulated for agency initialling. The meeting will also consider how the Administration should address other contentious amendments to the Compact.
