House Res. No. 2-0057-10

A HOUSE RESOLUTION

Requesting the Security Council of the United Nations and the Trusteeship Council of the United Nations to direct the United States, as the Administering Authority of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, to meet its obligations under the language and spirit of the Trusteeship Agreement.

1 WHEREAS, the Republic of Palau and the United States have
2 yet to resolve certain difficulties and differences which stand
3 in the way of implementation of the Compact of Free Association;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, Palau therefore remains a Trust Territory under
6 the Administering Authority of the United States, and the United
7 States remains subject to its obligations under the Trusteeship
8 Agreement; and

9 WHEREAS, it remains unknown when in the near or distant
10 future, the Compact will be implemented, and the Trusteeship
11 terminated; and

12 WHEREAS, Palau will remain entitled to all of its benefits
13 as a Trust Territory up until the day that the Trusteeship is
14 terminated; and

15 WHEREAS, it would be premature and patently unfair for
16 the United States to decrease its funding for Palau based upon
17 the anticipated termination of the Trusteeship; and

18 WHEREAS, we believe that the United States intends to
19 decrease its funding of Palau and will by reason thereof fail
20 to meet its obligations under the Trusteeship Agreement; now
21 therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Delegates of the Second
23 Olbiil Era Kelulau hereby requests the Security Council of the
24 United Nations and the Trusteeship Council of the United Nations
25 to direct the United States, as the Administering Authority
26 of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, to meet its


1 obligations under the language and spirit of the Trusteeship
2 Agreement; and


3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this

5 the Secretary of the Department of Interior, the President Pro
6 Tem and members of the United States Senate, the Speaker and
7 members of the United States House of Representatives, the
8 President of the Senate, Second Olbiil Era Kelulau, and the
9 Speaker of the House of Delegates, Second Olbiil Era Kelulau.
